## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

- This clinic is designed for you to bring one whole (or portion of one) choir of your choosing based on the needs of your school.
- You choose your literature for the clinic. Please remember...each group only has 15 minutes which includes performance of your piece and time to work with the clinician. Please bring a copy of your piece for the clinicians.
- If you bring bags and other items with you, these can be stored in the old gym during the school day.
- You will enter the risers SR and exit the risers SL during the clinic.
- You can either grab dinner in Nebraska City, pack some dinners with your or grab food in another town on the way home. If you're staying in Nebraska City, it would be thoughtful to give the food place a heads up that you're coming with a large group. We have McDonalds, Burger King, Pizza Hut, Runza, Subway, Arby's, Taco Bell, and Taco Johns all in town. I'm not sure that there's a great place to park and let the kids out to go to specific restaurants - they are quite spread out.
- The clinicians aren't worried about seeing scores ahead of time.
- Depending on where we perform (I need to know how many students are coming to figure this out) I'll let you know how we will get on and off of the risers.
- Stanek and Hansmeyer will help keep everyone on schedule and help organize groups during the concert.
- Performance Order for the concert is not alphabetical order. No one wants to be first every time. I'll mix it up but if you have a preference, please let me know. Especially if you have a great opener or closer.
- All directors should help with supervision and with making sure we stay on schedule.
